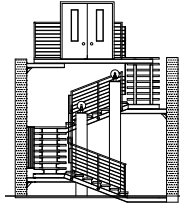

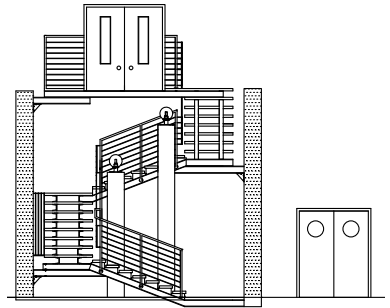

Details and appropriate areas of interest at different scales.



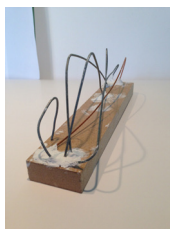
2 Staircase Design Upper Mills Wakefield

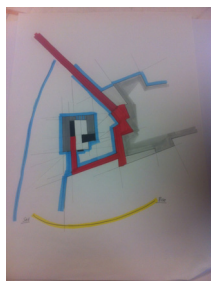
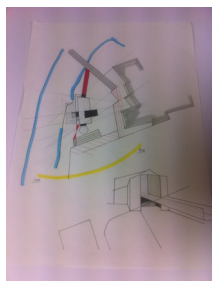
3 Model Making Scale 1:50
